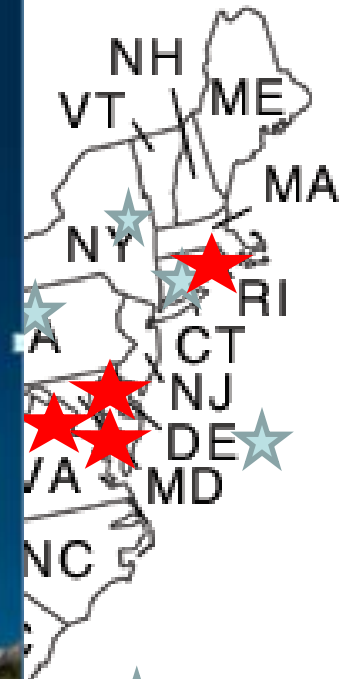

## THE 8 WASTES

-  **DEFECTS**  
Work that contains errors or lacks something necessary
-  **OVER PRODUCING**  
Generating more information than is needed right now, duplications and redundancies
-  **WAITING**  
Idle time created when actions or information are not ready
-  **NON-UTILIZED PEOPLE**  
Not fully utilizing or developing the skills, training, and passion of staff and students
-  **TRANSPORTATION**  
Unnecessary movements of information and materials
-  **INVENTORY**  
More resources or information than needed
-  **MOTION**  
Unnecessary physical movements, searching
-  **EXTRA PROCESSING**  
Extra or unnecessary steps, requirements or approvals

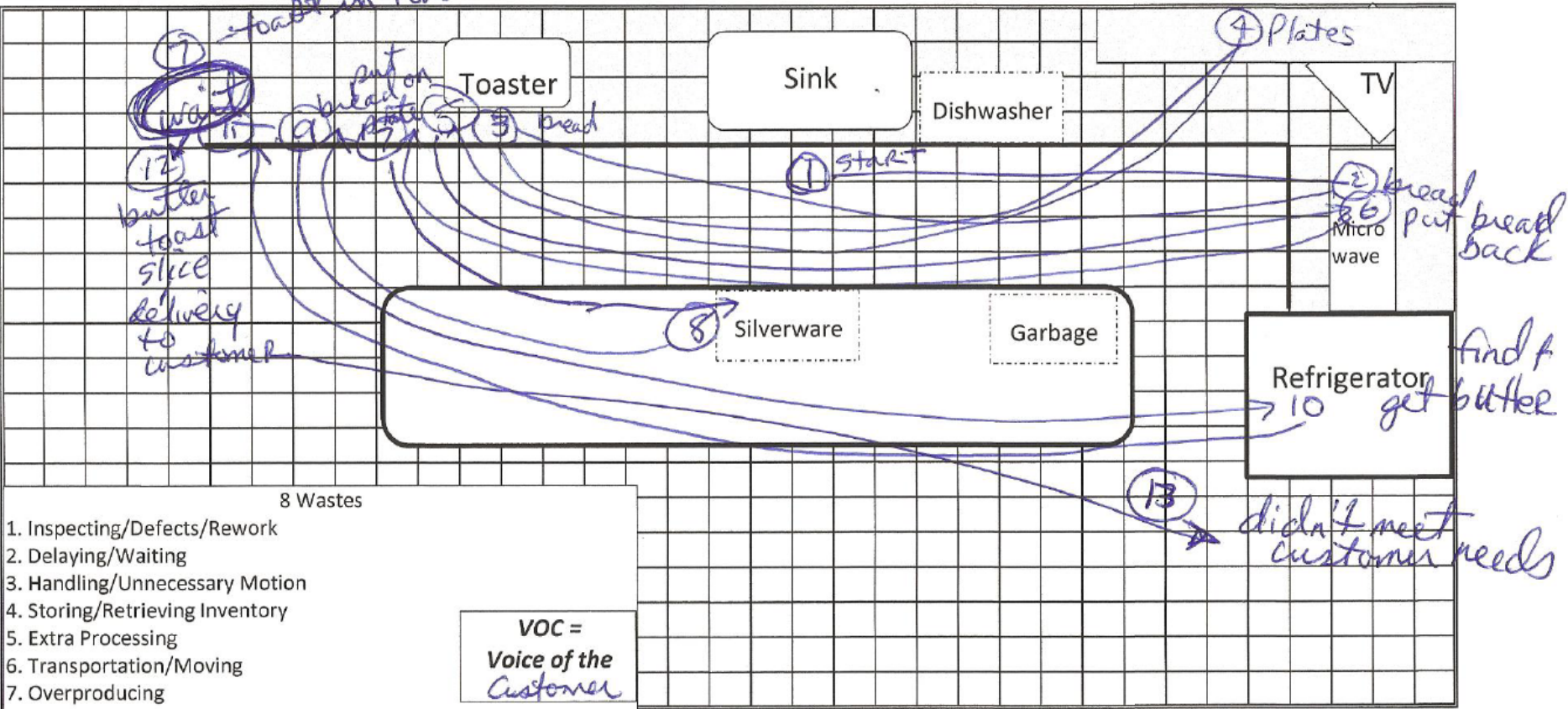

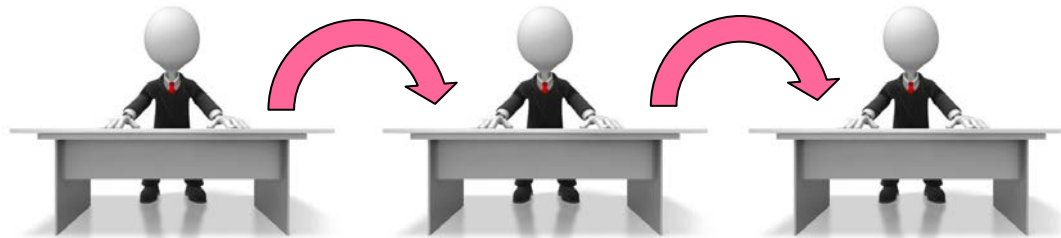

## Batch Processing (the norm) - Push



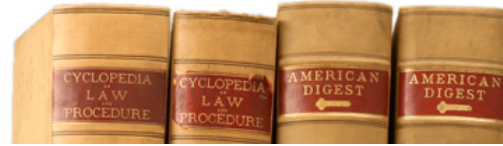
## One-Piece Flow - Pull

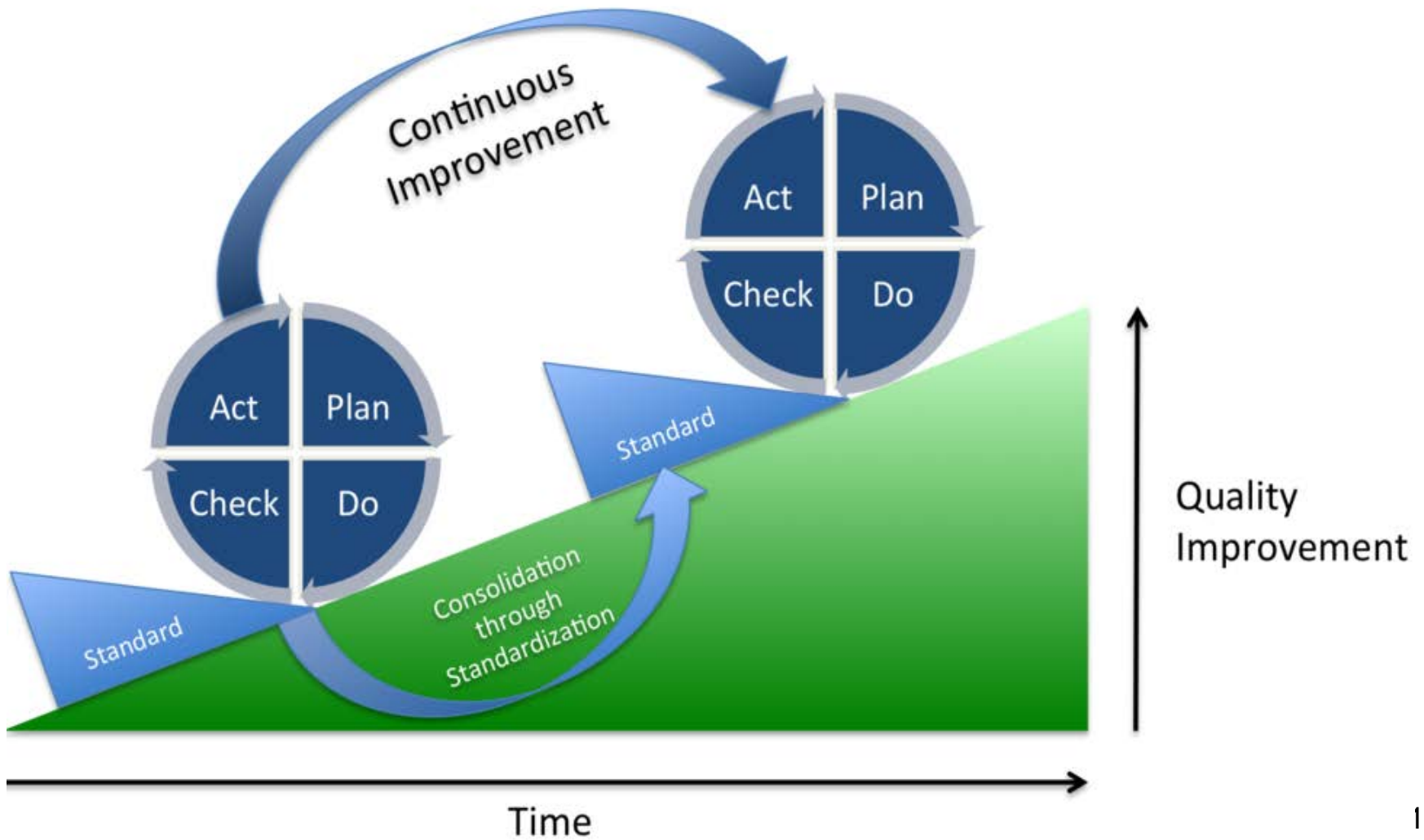

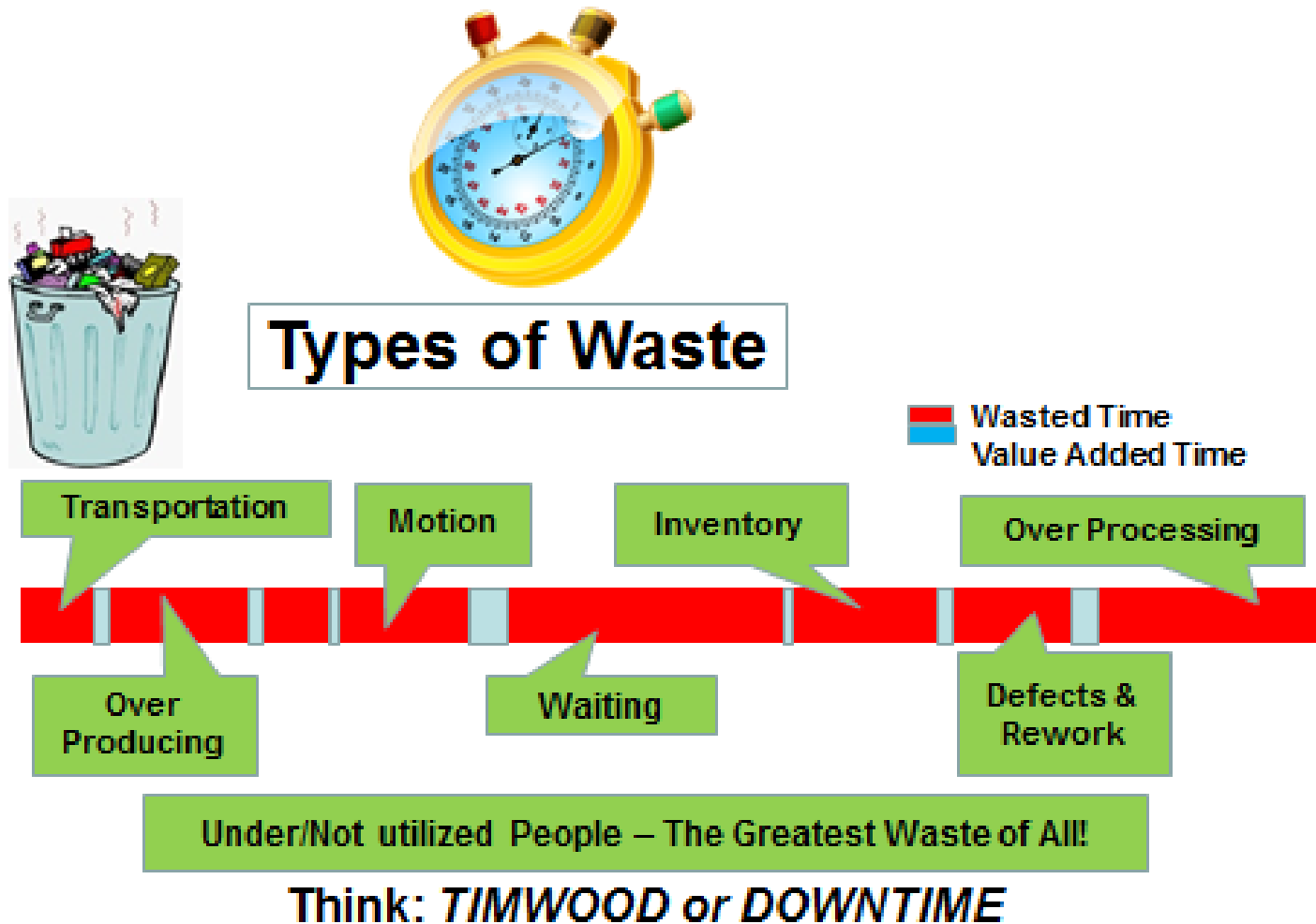

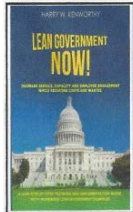
